Backflow preventors are an important element in protecting our water here in Florida. Most homes have these devices typically located in the front yards.

At Centerville Conservation Community one of the objectives is to keep the neighborhood aesthetically pleasing. Part of this compliance would be shielding the backflows from plain view with shrubs (examples as noted in the pictures to the right).

Moreover, the association highly recommends owners to learn about proper periodical maintenance to extend the life expectancy of the valves and various parts.

Most owners have already planted approved shrubs around their backflow preventors (Thank You). If you have not done so already, we ask that you take this time to move forward with this compliancy issue.

Please inquire if you are uncertain which plants are most appropriate and are deer resistant to install to shield your backflow preventor.
